A hot summer night in Berlin: 45,000 visitors at the Long Night of Museums

On Saturday, August 24, 2024, **45,000 visitors** were out and about late into the night at the Long Night of Museums. This year, they uncovered Berlin's secrets in 75 museums, where 750 events helped uncover the mysterious, creepy and thrilling things to discover at th 750 events.

Museum für Naturkunde was the most popular destination for night owls with around 7,800 visitors, followed by the Neues Museum with 7,300 visitors. 7,200 people came to the Humboldt Forum to take a ride in a vintage car through Berlin and then dance the night away to Afrobeats, disco, house and soul. While experimenting with secret codes, 5,200 interested visitors learned completely new skills at the German Spy Museum.

Of the smaller museums, the **Police Historical Collection**, the **Hanf Museum** and the **Puppet Theatre Museum**, among others, attracted many who were out and about with exciting programs and late-night specials.

The museums implemented this year's theme "Berlin Secrets" in a variety of ways and not only delighted visitors, but also surprised them with new insights and discoveries. For example, the **Samurai Museum** presented a Japanese sword found during excavations in Berlin-Mitte and the **Stasi Museum** presented a curious find in Erich Mielke's offices.

Ensembles from **Young Euro Classic**, Berlin's festival of international youth orchestras, performed Scottish folk music, township jazz from South Africa, Indian qawwali music and overtone singing from the Mongolian steppe at the Museum Island meeting point.

With the help of the new, **multifunctional website** and the **Museo-Mat**, visitors were able to filter the extensive program of the Long Night of Museums according to their interests, get suitable tips and plan their own routes.





The next Long Night of Museums will take place on August 30, 2025.
