LONG NIGHT OF MUSEUMS 2026: LATE NIGHT SPECIALS

On the trail of crime under cover of the night? Anyone who takes the Long Night of Museums at its word can wander around exhibition spaces and museums until 2 am. The highlights of the later hours are the Late Night Specials, which make their way through all the genres and explore this year's theme in many different ways: "Crime in Berlin".

With "Bodies in Motion", Constanza Macras / Dorky Park invite the public to a dance performance in the historic ruins of the lecture hall at the Berlin Museum of Medical History. At the Computer Games Museum, the LARP collective Monstrous Immersive (LARP = Live Action Role Playing) will be sending children and adults on a "Quest of Thieves", where there'll be plenty of tricky puzzles to solve. With a reading from the crime thriller "Die Weiße Nacht", author Anne Stern will take her listeners in the German Historical Museum all the way back to the ruins of postwar Berlin. At the Mori Ōgai Memorial, the play "Superhelden und Süßigkeiten" will be bringing the tradition of Japanese paper theatre "kamishibai" back to life. On top of that, late at night the show "Of Kingz and Queens and Criminal Queers" in the Gay Museum provides a drag-twist on the historical and persistent criminalisation of queer people and celebrates their powerful resistance. At midnight, goosebumps are guaranteed at the "Crime Poetry Slam" at the German Museum of Technology. And anyone who enjoys being on stage themselves should definitely not miss the "Killer Karaoke" in the Futurium – a dazzling karaoke party with variety show vibes.
